



Virginia Graeme Baker Act Compliance Site Audit Worksheet

The Virginia Graeme Baker (VGB) Act was signed into Federal law December 2007 to help the US prevent entrapment-related injuries and deaths in commercial pools. The deadline for mandatory compliance is December 19th, 2008. There are strict penalties for non-compliance including criminal and civil penalties, possible imprisonment, and federal fines up to \$1.8 million dollars.
